Dear Parents and Guardians:

Your son or daughter is interested in becoming a member of the Alief Middle School Cheerleading Squad. If selected there are specific responsibilities and obligations, which he or she must assume in order to qualify and remain part of the squad.

The Cheerleader Candidate has received a tryout packet, which includes information regarding tryouts and the tryout process. Please read all information so you and your child are aware of the expectations and requirements. All procedures will be followed with no exceptions (except emergencies only).

On the following pages, you will find the Cheerleader Tryout Qualifications and Requirements, Cheerleader Expectations, Projected Expense List, Important Upcoming Dates, Tryout Timetable, Expectations on Tryout Day, and the necessary forms to be completed. Please be aware tryouts packets and physicals are DUE by Friday, August 31, 2018. If the information is late or if the candidate fails to turn in any required paperwork, the candidate will be disqualified from cheerleader tryouts.

Being a cheerleader is a <u>FULL YEAR COMMITMENT</u> and requires an <u>extreme</u> amount of dedication from not only the cheerleader, but the family as well. If you and your child both feel the obligations and responsibilities can be met, please allow your child to participate in tryouts. If your child has been selected for the team, **there will be a mandatory parent meeting immediately following tryouts for approximately 45 minutes** in the school cafeteria.

2018-2019 Alief MS Cheerleading Tryout Information

Thank you for your interest in trying out for cheerleading/mascot. In this packet, you will find the following tryout information and the 2018-2019 Rules for Cheerleading. Please read this entire packet & constitution to understand procedures, rules, and expectations of Alief Middle School cheerleaders/mascots prior to tryouts.

Cheerleading/ Mascot Tryout Dates:

- Cheer Tryout Practice will be held on September 1st, 2018 from 8:00 AM- 4:15 PM. Tryout material will be taught during this time. The official tryout will take place from 3:00 to 4:15 pm.
- PAPER WORK AND PHYSICALS MUST BE TURNED IN NO LATER THAN AUGUST 31st. THERE WILL NOT BE ANY EXCEPTIONS MADE. IF PAPERWORK IS NOT TURNED IN ON TIME, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO TRYOUT.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL PAGES ARE SIGNED BY YOU AND YOUR PARENTS PLEASE. If you are missing any signatures, you will **not** be eligible to tryout and will be sent home.
- The tryout results will be shared with the candidates immediately following the tryouts. The candidates who *were not selected*, will need to exit the building after tryouts results are posted.

Eligibility:

To be eligible for the 2018-2019 year for cheerleading, the student must:

- Be enrolled in the 6th, 7th, or 8th grade at Alief Middle School for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Have completed all paperwork with appropriate signatures and turned in on time.
- Be passing all core classes with a 70% or higher on report card for all classes on for the 17-18 school year. → This is to ensure that you will remain eligible upon making the squad per UIL Guidelines. Non satisfactory grades will be accepted but will negatively impact tryout score.
- Have satisfactory school conduct. Your school discipline record will be reviewed for the 17-18 school year. This will be signed off by a school administrator which will indicate your eligibility for tryouts. Major offenses will cause you to be ineligible to tryout.

Selection of the cheerleaders will be based on the following:

- A cheer, a chant, and dance that will be taught to the participants during the tryout practices.
- Jumps- a toe touch (required) and then choice of second jump.
- Scholastic achievement and conduct eligibility
- Conduct during tryout practices and tryouts

• Attitude, initiative, teamwork, leadership, work ethic, enthusiasm, and coachability during tryout practices & tryouts.

What do you wear to tryouts?

- Lightweight /light sole tennis shoes (Please try to avoid Jordan's, Toms, slides/slip-ons/flats, etc.) *They weigh you down when you jump.*
- WHITE t-shirt long enough to cover your midriff when your hands are raised. No tanks or spaghetti straps allowed.
- **BLACK** Shorts long enough to cover your bottoms.
- Your hair should be off your shoulders, and no jewelry should be worn. You may wear a white or black bow in your hair if you choose.

For those who make the squad:

There will be a MANDATORY parent meeting IMMEDIATELY following the tryouts in the cafeteria. Cheerleaders will be fitted for cheer gear on during practice the week of September 4th. Please mark your calendar. A deposit of \$100.00 (cash) for cheer equipment/fees will have to be made by September 7th or sooner for new members. Returning members will need to pay \$50. Cheerleader will forfeit their spot on the team if payment can't be made. Making this payment will allow me to order cheer equipment in a timely manner for games, events, performances, etc.

Total Estimated Maximum Costs of Cheer Equipment and Fees= \$200 for new cheerleaders. The payments will be broken into 2 payments. (1) September 7th- \$100, (2) October 5th- \$100. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR UNDISTRIBUTED CHEER ITEMS. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Failure to pay will result in administrative action. Cheer gear **WILL NOT** be given out until balance is paid in FULL. Cheer shoes are not included in this fee and will need to be purchased on your own from Academy. (Brand: BCG - \$20).

*Returning Cheerleader Payment Schedule: (1) \$50 (2) \$40 following the same dates above.

**PHYSICALS are required in order to tryout and will remain on file with the coach and PE coaches.

2018-2019 Alief Middle School Cheerleading

<u>Purpose</u>

The objective of the AMS cheerleading squad is to effectively execute a school spirit program that supports the athletic teams and promotes the school itself. Cheerleaders will serve as positive role models and leaders for AMS, and should promote sportsmanship within our school and among other schools. The highest priority should be to display and encourage spirit and pride for AMS.

Squad Members and Practices

- Members will be chosen at a formal tryout session.
- Members MUST participate in all tryout practices.

Practices and Games

- Squads will have practices each week. A schedule will be given out at the beginning of each
 month. All practices are mandatory and other schedules should revolve around cheerleading
 practices. Additional practices may be added when needed and we will try to do it a week ahead of
 time so parents and cheerleaders can plan for it. We appreciate your flexibility.
- During football season, games are usually held on Mondays/Tuesdays; however the schedule is subject to change. You will also be given a schedule at the beginning of the season, and cheerleaders will be expected to be present at all games that are assigned on the monthly schedule. We will try to follow all schedules as closely as possible.

Attendance Requirements

- ABSENCES CAN BE THE DOWNFALL OF A GREAT CHEERLEADING SQUAD! If one or more squad members are absent from a practice or game, the other members are forced to make last minute changes. This can be both stressful and dangerous to squad members.
- You will be expected to be at all games and practices. <u>Academics first</u>, AMS cheer second to all
 other activities. Remember, joining other clubs and sports will cause you to have to split your time
 which can run you the risk of forfeiting your position is routines/performances.
- If you commit to cheerleading you are committing to attend every game. Unexcused absences are those caused by anything other than illness or family emergencies. In addition, just because a cheerleader asks to be excused doesn't mean that the excuse will be granted. Absences must be asked for and excused.
- If you are ill or have a family emergency, the coach needs to be notified by a parent or guardian in order for this absence to be excused. Please notify the coach before the absence.
- Students must be present half the school day (full 2 class periods) to be eligible for practices and games scheduled for that day.



Grades

- A minimum grade of a 70 must be maintained throughout the cheering season (each 9 weeks) in each class period.
- Cheerleaders are students first and athletes second, therefore grades will be monitored by the
 coach every 3 weeks. If a student is failing ANY class at report card, they will be ineligible to
 participate in cheer for 3 weeks. They may attend practice, however, attending tutorials in lieu of
 practice is encouraged because the cheerleader will be unable to attend any games or
 performances during their loss period.
- Cheerleaders need to be sure to schedule tutorials with a teacher to maintain passing grades. Just
 be sure to inform a coach that you will be attending tutorials in a timely manner. Teachers usually
 have the same schedule throughout the school year. Telling a coach at the last minute that you are
 attending tutorials is unacceptable and truly can impact the practice schedule, thus hurting the
 team.

Expected Behavior

- All AMS guidelines for student conduct must be followed at all times.
- <u>Promote a positive image for the school community—your peers, parents, teachers, and community members</u>.
- While representing AMS (especially in CHEER UNIFORMS/ATTIRE), cheerleaders must not:
 - Drink alcoholic beverages
 - Use controlled substances/ tobacco products
 - Show unsportsmanlike conduct
 - Bully peers (at all!)
 - Use profanity
 - Vandalize any areas in and around the school, or in the community
 - Show displays of affection (No PDA)
 - Be academically dishonest
 - Inappropriate content on social media websites
- You must attend all practices and games. Unless there is an emergency. Parents should contact a coach.
- Your attitude and ability to work with other different personalities must be exceptional.
- Lying or fabricating the truth will not be tolerated and can result in immediate termination from the squad.
- Part of a coach's job is to know where you are at all times during practices, games, and special events. Consequences will be issued for failure to follow the coach's direction or to stay in assigned areas during events.
- While safety is our number one goal, please understand that you should expect bumps, bruises, and other occasional minor injuries. This is all part of cheerleading. It is also important to keep horseplaying to a minimum to avoid unnecessary injuries.
- All official cheerleading decisions and activities will be made by the Coaches. All coaches are to be given respect and cooperation by cheerleaders and parents at all times.
- Lack of respect will not be tolerated and can be grounds for dismissal.

Being in correct uniform means wearing the appropriate uniform—black sports bra, bloomers, hair ribbon, socks, shoes having hair pulled up. Complete uniform also means wearing no jewelry, glitter, or extremely bright fingernail polish. Your nails must be trimmed short.

Coaches, sponsors, and/or principals reserve the right to make changes/additions to the rules as needed. In addition, if you have any questions or concerns, please respect the following chain of command:


